

## **Application call: UCLA Extension scholarships 2022-23 with UIC Barcelona**

This agreement allows UIC Barcelona students who completed one of the following bachelor's degrees: Advertising and Public Relations, Audiovisual Communication, Business Administration and Management, Architecture, Bioengineering, Biomedicine, Psychology, Law or Humanities, to apply for the **UCLA Extension Certificate programme** and benefit from a **10% discount**. UIC Barcelona also allocates **three scholarships of €2,000 each to help you pursue a postgraduate course at UCLA Extension**. Students will cover remaining costs themselves, including the rest of the enrolment fees, accommodation, travel, visa and meals.

This course is equivalent to a postgraduate degree, with a **flexible duration** (normally nine months) that gives you the chance to **specialise** and gain **professional experience** in your area of expertise.

There are many advantages for students who benefit from this agreement as, in addition to reducing the cost of the programme, it offers unique opportunities for gaining professional experience in the United States. On the one hand, several of its programmes include placements in the relevant field, and on the other hand, it gives you the option to stay and work in the country once the programme has finished, with a 12-month work permit (OPT visa).

### **Academic requirements to participate**

1. **Students must be in their last year of the degree programme, or already graduated, at the time of applying for the funding.** To receive the scholarship, it is necessary to have obtained all the credits from UIC Barcelona before the end of the fourth academic year (July), otherwise, the scholarship will be lost.
2. **Demonstrate at least a B2 level of English** with a language qualification (each programme requires a minimum score in the TOEFL, IELTS or ITEP tests).

### **Application process**

To participate, you must fill in the UCLA Scholarship [application form](#) and submit the following documentation **the latest on Friday 25 February 2022** to the International Relations Service at [exchange.bcn@uic.es](mailto:exchange.bcn@uic.es) (degrees on the Barcelona campus) or at [exchange.scu@uic.es](mailto:exchange.scu@uic.es) (degrees on the Sant Cugat campus):

- CV
- Language certificate<sup>1</sup>
- Academic transcript where the average mark out of 10 appears<sup>2</sup>

Each Faculty will undertake the first assessment of its applicants. Applications that are eligible for funding will be assessed by means of a personal interview, against the following criteria:

- Academic transcript 40%
- English level 20%
- Student profile and motivation 20%
- Faculty recommendation 10%
- Financial necessities 10%

The final resolution regarding grant allocation is the responsibility of the International Relations Service, which reserves the right to accept or reject applications and will notify the Grants Committee.

## Other regulations

The same student can receive the scholarship only once. Students will have to start their Certificate programme between August 2022 - September 2023. The scholarship can't be transferred to another **academic year**.

## Payment of the scholarship

UIC Barcelona will pay the scholarship to the students once they arrive at UCLA Extension and start their classes.

1. **Deadline for applications:** 25 February 2022
2. **Invitation to the interview:** week of 14 March 2022
3. **Interviews:** 21-25 March 2022
4. **Resolution by email:** 30 March 2022
5. **Deadline for accepting/declining offers:** 6 April 2022
6. **Waiting list:** applicants on the waiting list will be informed in order of the ranking if a scholarship becomes available
7. **Meeting with UCLA Extension:** tentative, week of 18 April 2022

<sup>1</sup> Not presenting a certificate according to UCLA Extension requirements is not a reason for declining the application, but will affect the evaluation according to the percentage indicated for the language certificate. In any case, before going to UCLA Extension, all students must fulfill the English certificate requirement marked by UCLA Extension.
