Cambridge B2 First Preparation Course

Main language of instruction: English

Presentation

This is a 100 -hour course that includes an official exam through which students can certify a B2 level of English under the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). It is an exam preparation course with an emphasis on the techniques and criteria that need to be mastered in order to pass an official Cambridge B2 First exam (First Certificate) in all skill areas: speaking, reading comprehension, listening comprehension, use of language and writing. The course will be 50 hours face to face via video conference as well as 50 hours of independent study with additional online support material.

This course does not include registration fees for the official Cambridge B2 First exam.

Pre-course requirements

Students should have a B2.1 level at the beginning of the course to be able to successfully pass the B2 exam.

Objectives

To be able to successfully pass an official B2 level exam and earn a B2 level certificate in language competency in English, under the CEFR. The course will prepare students for the Cambridge First Certificate B2 exam.

Syllabus

The syllabus is based on the Compact First Digital Student and Workbook from Cambridge. The Compact Digital Student's book will be the basis for the face to face classes. The course involves learning the five skills and competencies necessary to pass an official B2 exam. Practice exams in the five areas will be done throughout the course as well as the necessary support material. Autonomous learning will be done using the Compact Digital Workbook.

Evaluation systems and criteria

There will be continual feedback based on work done in class and the results of practice exams. To pass and earn credit for the course, students must attend at least 80% of the classes and complete the assignments.



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The exam will be administered by Cambridge Exams and must be taken on the days and times established by them. There is no make-up exam or second opportunity .

Accreditation

Certificate of attendance and workshop completion. To pass the course it is essential to have attended at least 80% of the classes.

Once you have passed the exam, you will receive a Certificate from Cambridge Exams.
