Useful information before applying for a Spanish Social Security Affiliation Number with a Passport

A Spanish Social Security Number (NUSS) is a number the Spanish Social Security Office uses to identify you. It is also known as an Affiliation Number (NAF). The Social Security Affiliation Number is a twelve-digit number.

What you need

- Your identity document (passport)
- Email address
- Device with a camera to take a picture (computer, mobile...)
- TA1 Application for Affiliation Number document duly completed and signed. This PDF document is attached to the documents in this guide.

Time period

You can submit your application at any time. If needed, we will contact you at the email or phone number you have provided.

Aimed at

- Any citizen who does not have digital identification and need to obtain personalised information or process formal paperwork.

Steps to follow

1 Access the Spanish Social Security website

2 Click on “Send request”

3 Fill in all the requested data fields.

— You will need to take a profile picture showing your passport document as instructed in the image. Once you have all the data filled in, click on “Continue.”

4 — You will receive the instructions from Spanish Social Security Office to obtain your Social Security Affiliation Number (twelve digits).

— **When you register, you must report this affiliation number to the Admission Services / your Faculty.** You can do this at the Faculty Secretary Office.
