## VISA APPLICATION FROM A SPANISH CONSULATE ABROAD

The student visa application can be processed in 90 days before the program starts. The first step is getting an appointment at the Consulate of Spain in the nearest city of the student domicile.

This is a list of the documents that an international student must submit when applying for a student visa. The list might vary a bit from one Consulate to another, but those are the minimum requirements:

- Acceptance letter
- Passport and copy
- Money Order (there is a fee tax you have to pay at the Embassy)
- Two National Visa Application forms (Original and copy).
- Two recent pictures glued to application
- Proof of health insurance
- Proof of Means of support (the student must show a bank account balance higher than 6.600€, plus the school fees and the flight tickets).
  In case the family of the student is supporting him/her, they have to get at the notary a legalized and translated certificate which shows the following:
  - o Bank status from parents account or pay slips
  - They have to declare they will help you economically by transferring you at least 600 € /month.
- Health Certificate translated into Spanish. The certificate he/she would need is a medical test which shows he/she doesn't have any infectious disease or any acute disease according to the International Health Regulation from 2005.
- **Police clearance** from the countries where he/she has lived during the past five year. The document must be legalized and translated into Spanish

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
