Two grants covering 50% of the tuition fee will be awarded.

## Requirements

Academic excellence is a priority for the awarding of this grant, however, since available funds are limited, the per capita income of the family unit will also be considered in the allocation of the grant in the case of several candidates with the same level of academic excellence.

The candidate must present the last income tax receipt presented by the family unit to be eligible for the grant

## Academic requirements

There is a limited number of grants available. The following requirements are required to access the call, but do not guarantee the grant

- Have a minimum average mark of 8 in the first year of their Baccalaureate and studies that correspond to the second year of their Baccalaureate, or the equivalent if they are foreign students.
- Have the B2 First (or equivalent) in English
- Pass the specific test for the UIC Barcelona Bachelor's Degree in Dentistry in the Grants for Academic Excellence call, and successfully complete the personal interview.
- Have a minimum university entrance mark of 11.5 (university entrance exam plus baccalaureate mark).
- Register for a minimum of 60 credits per course
