

a) Specific requirements for the Bachelor Degree in Psychology

Who can apply?

- Students who have not failed any subjects during the year prior to the mobility. If the student has failed a subject at the time of applying for mobility, the faculty will confirm whether or not they can go ahead with the process.

When does the mobility begin?

- The mobility will take place during the 1st semester of the 4th year.
- Students will be able to do extracurricular internships in summer abroad.

Criteria for allocation of places

- Academic record
- Number of available places
- Other (academic merits, suitability of destination, language, etc.)

Information to consider

- **This regulation does not apply to double degree students (EDU + PSYCH)**

Please note that host universities reserve the right to set their own admission criteria for certain subjects or programmes and may require that candidate students **demonstrate competence and/or a certain language level to access them.**

b) Specific requirements Double Degree Psychology - Education

Who can apply?

- Students who have not failed any subjects during the year prior to the mobility. If the student has failed a subject at the time of applying for mobility, the faculty will confirm whether or not they can go ahead with the process.

What options do I have?

- **DD Education and Psychology:**

Option 1 (studies): Mobility is only possible in the first semester of the 5th year, during the period of PSYCH electives.

Option 2 (work placements): They can be done during the 1st semester of the 6th year (final year) of EDU.
