All students who went to international volunteer projects attended previous training and awareness sessions. Three hours of training and awareness were provided per project. Countries: India, Kenya, Uganda, Jordan, Greece, and Tanzania.



- Social Credit project

UIC Barcelona encouraged its students to participate in volunteering through the [Social Credit](#) project. This project allowed students to obtain credits in exchange for participating in different volunteer or solidarity activities. In the case of the bachelor's degree in Medicine or Psychology, it was an essential requirement to perform 50 hours of volunteering with a social organisation. In the 2022-2023 academic year, 45 students from the Bachelor's Degree in Medicine and 18 students from the Bachelor's Degree in Psychology participated.

[The Solidarity Curricular Practicum](#) had been in operation since 2016. The degree programmes that incorporated it were the following: Law, Business Administration, Audiovisual Communication, Journalism, Advertising and Public Relations, Humanities, and Nursing. It was a teaching methodology that aimed to develop skills such as empathy, flexibility, adaptability, commitment, an attitude of selfless service, time management, and initiative, among others. It consisted of 30 hours of dedication by the student to a volunteer activity in an organisation that provided support to vulnerable people. Managers of the organisations kept track of the student's progress and sent an evaluation at the end of the placement. After the 30 hours of volunteering, the student had to deliver a journal about their experience. This activity was part of a subject. In most cases, the placement was 20% of the

final mark and was not mandatory. The student could choose to do the placement or a different assignment. 90 students participated in the 2022-2023 academic year.

The first session of the course, entitled “Healthy sexuality, strong bonds”, brought leading academic experts to address pornography addiction and its new challenges.



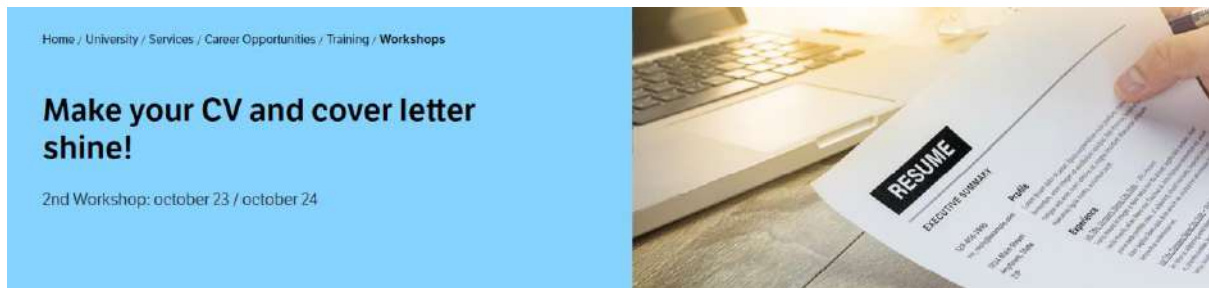
