Freedom of education, a human right

During his speech, Ignasi Grau insisted that the Universal Declaration of Human Rights established in 1948 that freedom of education was a human right and pointed out that “the father or mother had a preferential right to choose the form of education that would be given to their child.” That was why it was important, according to Grau, to protect this right.

According to the specialist in educational policies, “the disconnection between the educational project and family values was traumatic.” Accordingly, he stressed that “societies were increasingly pluralistic, so it was very important to take into account cultural identity and that education had to be linked to it.”

The importance of professional self-knowledge came from the fact that this process was precisely what allowed you to know your strengths and how to communicate them, your weaknesses and how to solve them, what distinguished you as a professional, or what professional goals you could aim toward.
