**Introduction**

The Official Master's Degree in Legal, Forensic and Criminological Psychopathology at the Universitat Internacional de Catalunya (UIC) demonstrates through its academic program, and by delving into the specialization of psychopathology applied to the forensic and judicial field, that students acquire the professional competencies, skills, and abilities in clinical, forensic, legal, and criminological areas demanded by the current and future professional landscape in mental health and the legal, forensic, and criminological sciences.

**Objectives**

The aim of the External Internships is to develop practical application of the discipline and provide students with the necessary hands-on experience in direct contact with the professional field, enabling them to perform professional functions and competencies effectively and efficiently.

**Contents**

The course comprises two internship blocks (A and B). Each student must complete an internship in one center from each block (approximately 7 credits per center), meaning each student will intern at two different centers.

In Block A, internships are mainly conducted at the Technical Advisory Service in the Family Law Area (EATAF), the Specialized Service for Intensive Psychiatric Rehabilitation (SERPI), Brians 1 (UHPP), Brians 2, and CP Joves penitentiary centers, and the Els Til·lers Educational Center.

In Block B, internships are conducted in various centers affiliated with Hestia Alliance and Parc Salut Mar, as well as private practices (Dr. Ortega-Monasterio, Ms. Navas, Dr. Vizcaíno, Ms. Micciola, Dr. Riera, and Dr. Gassó). Mandatory visits to different centers and attendance at trials are also included.

**Methodology and Learning Activities**

This compulsory 14-credit course is carried out directly in centers with which the Universitat Internacional de Catalunya (UIC) has signed educational cooperation agreements.

The main goal of the Practicum is for students to gain firsthand experience with the clinical application of psychopathology in the context of forensic, criminological, legal, and judicial sciences.

**Assessment Methods and Criteria**

Attendance is mandatory. Additionally, students must submit a report (a template is provided below) at the end of each internship period, reflecting the knowledge acquired. Similarly, the internship tutor will prepare an evaluation report for each student.

The final grade will be the arithmetic average of the grades received from the two internship centers.
