

## Admission and Entrance Tests

### What is the admission process for the ADE degree?

The admission process includes applying through the UIC Barcelona platform, uploading the required documents, and taking an entrance test.

### What does the ADE entrance test involve?

The test includes:

- A personal interview with a faculty member.
- An English language test to assess proficiency.
- A general intelligence test.

### When is the next entrance test?

The next test will be held on 24 April 2024.

## Scholarships and Financial Aid

### Are there scholarships available for ADE in English?

Yes, there are two types of scholarships for ADE in English:

- The International Excellence Scholarship (BEI), aimed at international students, which covers between 20% and 30% of the total tuition fees.
- The Academic Excellence Scholarship (BEA), for those who completed secondary education in Spain, which covers between 20% and 80% of the total tuition fees.

## Language and Academic Requirements

### What level of English is required for ADE in English?

To graduate, students must certify a B2 level in English. However, you may begin the course without this certification.

### How can I submit my academic transcripts for admission?

You must upload your final transcript from your most recently completed academic year to the admissions platform. The final diploma is not required at this stage.

Once admitted:

- If you come from the Spanish national education system, you must provide the university entrance exam results with the secure verification code (CSV), a certified copy of the secondary school diploma or proof of diploma application, and the bank receipt for the diploma fee payment (photocopy).
- If you studied within the EU or under another European education system, you must process the UNEDASSIS accreditation.
- If you studied outside the EU or under a non-European system, you must apply for the homologation of your diploma and submit the conditional enrolment receipt issued by the Spanish Ministry of Education when the homologation process begins.

## Visa and Documentation

### Do I need a visa to study at UIC Barcelona?

If you are a non-EU student, you must apply for a student visa. Once you are admitted and have paid the reservation fee, UIC Barcelona will issue a visa letter to support your application.

### What documents are required for enrolment?

Before the academic year begins, you must provide:

- Passport or national ID.
- Final grades from your last year of secondary school.
- Informed consent form regarding the third language requirement (a B2 level in a third language is required upon graduation).
- Proof of tuition payment.

## Campus Visits and University Life

### Can I visit the campus before enrolling?

Yes, we offer guided tours that must be booked at least one week in advance.

### What percentage of international students are enrolled in ADE in Spanish and in English?

In ADE in Spanish, fewer than 20% are international students.

In ADE in English, over 40% are international.

### What is the class schedule like?

The degree lasts four years.

ADE in Spanish: 1st and 3rd years in the morning; 2nd and 4th years in the afternoon.

ADE in English: classes are held in the morning for all four years.

Additionally, there are extracurricular activities that promote networking with companies, such as the B-Excellent programme, IESE week, and the UIC Barcelona Company Day.

## Internships and Erasmus/ Exchange Programmes

**When do internships start?** Internships are available from the 4th year onwards. They are optional but highly recommended due to the excellent agreements we have with companies.

**Which companies does UIC have agreements with?** Some of our partner companies include: KPMG, Deloitte, PwC, NTT DATA, Nestlé, Seat, Almirall, EY, Pronovias, Cuatrecasas, Deutsche Bank, Casio, Accenture, Andbank, Mercedes, Ferrero, Mango, Inditex, Lidl, Telefónica.

**Can I do an Erasmus?** Yes, from the 4th year onwards. You can participate in Erasmus+ within the EU or in an international exchange outside of it. We have agreements with countries such as: Germany, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Brazil, Belgium, Canada, Chile, Colombia, South Korea, Croatia, Ecuador, Spain, the United States, the Philippines, Finland, France, the Netherlands, Hong Kong, Italy, Lithuania, Malta, Mexico, Peru, Poland, Portugal, the United Kingdom, Czech Republic, Panama, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, and Uruguay.

## Tuition Fees

### What are the tuition fees for the degree?

ADE in Spanish: €12,120 per year. ADE in English: €12,720 per year. Duration: 4 years.

## Double Degrees

### How is the double degree in ADE + Industrial Production Engineering structured?

The first 3 years take place at UIC, the 4th year at PoliTo (Turin), and the 5th year back at UIC.

### How is the double degree in ADE + (Finance, Economics, Marketing) structured?

The first 3 years take place at UIC, the 4th year at Birkbeck (London), and the 5th year back at UIC.

### Are there other double degrees available?

Yes. There are double degrees with Humanities and with Law. Both last 5 years. The Humanities double degree begins with Humanities, while the Law double degree begins with ADE.
