

General Information

How many places are available in the Bachelor's Degree in Bioengineering?

40 places.

How much does the first year of the Bachelor's Degree in Bioengineering cost?

You can check it at uic.es/bio

Do students need to buy books for classes?

No, the teaching material can be found on the university's digital platform and in the library.

What types of scholarships or financial aid can I receive to study Bioengineering?

To promote excellence, we offer the BEA Scholarships (Academic Excellence Scholarship) for domestic students and the BEI Scholarships (International Excellence Scholarship) for international students.

BEA – If you have an average grade of 8 out of 10 in the first year of high school or a 9 in the first year of a Higher Vocational Training Course (CFGS), you can apply for an Academic Excellence Scholarship, with a discount of up to 80%.

BEI – If you have an average grade of 8 out of 10 in the course equivalent to the first year of high school, you can apply for an International Excellence Scholarship, with a discount of up to 30%.

What is the class schedule?

Theoretical classes take place from Monday to Friday, either in the morning or afternoon, depending on the year of study.

When do practical sessions begin?

In the first year, we have practical sessions in the laboratories. In the second and third years, practical sessions become more intensive, and in the fourth year, students undertake internships in companies within the sector.

Can I do an international stay during the degree?

Yes. In the second semester of the fourth year, we encourage students to carry out their Bachelor's Thesis (TFG) and internships abroad. Thanks to our numerous partnerships and the ease of managing agreements, international mobility is very accessible.

Access routes to the degree

What if I finished high school more than two years ago and have not started university studies?

We do not have a minimum entry grade (cut-off mark). As long as you have passed the PAU (university entrance exams), you can apply for admission.

Can I apply through the high school route if I have started or completed university studies?

No, the access route for students who have started or completed university studies is specific.

Can I take the admission tests if I studied a social, humanities, or arts-focused high school program?

Yes.

Can I take the admission tests if I completed a Higher Vocational Training program (CFGS) that is not related to health?

Yes.

Tests and admission processes

What is the minimum grade required to access the Bachelor's Degree in Bioengineering?

Since this is a private university, there is no minimum entry grade requirement. Admission depends on the results of the corresponding entrance exams.

What do the entrance exams consist of?

The exams include:

- English test
- Subject-specific test (Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics)
- Personal interview

Can I choose the date for the entrance exams?

You can request a specific date, but you must wait for confirmation from the Information and Admissions Service. After reviewing your documentation, they will notify you via email with the assigned test date.

Can I review sample exam questions?

We do not provide past exam samples. However, you can check the syllabus at <https://bit.ly/49PC7T7>

Are the tests online?

Yes, both the multiple-choice test and the personal interview are conducted 100% online.

What level of English is required for the exam?

A B2 level or higher.

How is the admission score calculated?

- 50% from your academic record
- 40% from the specific tests (English test + subject-specific test for Bioengineering)
- 10% from the personal interview

What is the schedule for the exams?

The tests are usually held at 9 a.m. CET, but if you are unable to take them at this time, we can adjust the schedule.

When will I receive the admission results?

Results will be communicated via email approximately 10-15 business days after taking the exams.

If I receive a “not admitted” result, can I apply for the next session within the same academic year?

No, you can only take the entrance exams once per academic year.

If I am admitted, what is the next step?

You will receive an admission letter with instructions on how to reserve your place, which requires a payment of 20% of the first-year tuition fee.

The remaining 80% will be paid during the enrollment period and throughout the first year (if you choose the installment payment option).

If I decide not to enroll at UIC Barcelona after reserving my place, can I get a refund?

The reservation fee is only fully refunded if you do not meet the academic requirements for enrollment.

This condition is outlined in the general terms and conditions document.
