


FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

LAW



Is the Law Degree at UIC Barcelona officially recognised?

Yes.

What is the minimum number of subjects I must enrol in during the first year?

In the first year of any of our degree programmes, it is compulsory to enrol in the full number of credits allocated for the first year. In the case of the Law Degree, this amounts to 60 ECTS credits.

Is there an academic progress policy at UIC Barcelona?

Yes. On the one hand, as a first-year student in any degree or programme, you must pass at least 60% of your credits in order to progress to the second year. On the other hand, in subsequent years, you must pass at least 50% of the credits you enrol in to continue with your studies.

Can I do an internship in a company related to my studies?

Yes. In fact, the curriculum for the Law Degree includes the possibility of doing professional internships in law firms, courts, and other legal institutions during the second semester of the fourth year.

Can I take a double degree?

Yes, you can choose from several double degrees offered at UIC Barcelona:

- Business Administration (ADE) + Law
- Humanities and Cultural Studies + Law

You can also pursue international double degree options, such as:

- Law + International Studies
- Law + Political Science at Iona College (New York)

Or complement the Law Degree with the

- Certificate Programme in Paralegal Studies at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA).

How long are the classes?

Classes typically last two hours, with a 10-minute break.

When are exams held?

At the end of each semester, in January and May.

What is the cost of the degree?

The degree costs €11,940 for the first year (€199/ECTS x 60 ECTS). It is a 4-year course.
