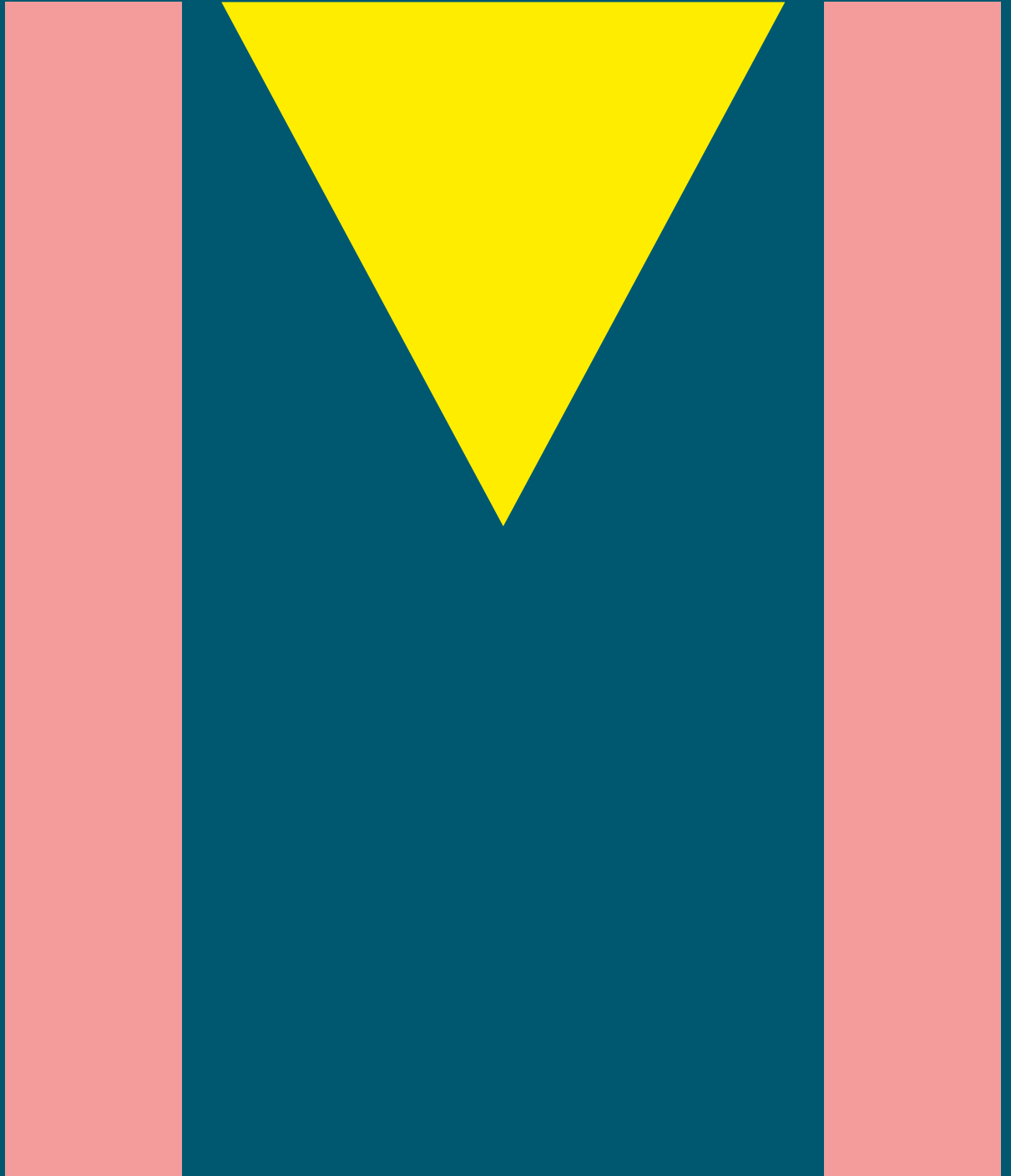

At UIC Barcelona, our medicine is focused on the patient. We help you acquire a broad scientific knowledge base and teach you to support any patient you see through the healthcare system.

Our curriculum is fully recognised by the European Higher Education Area. We promote teaching using innovative and interdisciplinary methodologies by specialists in the field of the health. So you actively develop the scientific and human competences that the society of the future needs.

By studying the Bachelor's Degree in Medicine, you will be in contact with patients from day one. As a student, you are at the centre of our mission and you will be involved in all decisions regarding the degree programme.

PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS

If you have a vocational attitude and are committed to society through science and health, this is the degree programme for you.

We encourage human values and highly value service orientation and person-centred care.

We rely on critical thinking, clinical reasoning, human sensitivity, interpersonal skills and teamwork.

FACILITIES

You will study on our Sant Cugat Campus, part of the **Hospital Universitari General de Catalunya**, and use the facilities at our Comprehensive Centre for Advanced Simulation, spanning more than 1,000 m², including an outpatient area, a home care area, a surgical area, a specialised area, and another hospital area with 16 beds.

You'll also have access to training, debriefing and image control rooms with video recording facilities in all areas.

You can access the anatomy unit, with three dissection rooms, an osteology collection and the biochemistry laboratory.

WORK PLACEMENTS

You will be in contact with patients from year one thanks to more than 2,200 hours of clinical work experience that form part of the degree programme. You will undertake international work placements through our exchange programmes and Erasmus agreements. We have a one-to-one student-teacher ratio. We have work placement agreements with national and international institutions. These include:

- 4 university centres
- 12 associated centres
- 1 university primary care centre
- 20 primary care associated centres

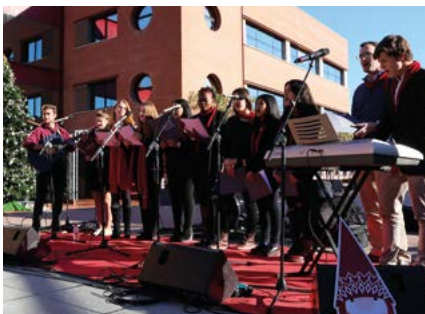

At Student Services, we facilitate students' integration into the university system.
