






- Promote internships abroad

But also like this:












Jokes aside, when I look at my life and I know that I am:

Why would someone not want to go and study or live abroad?


And then it hit me...


What is happening that you may not want to "try" it?

Get some piece of paper and pen (better than using the phone)




















What if it doesn't work out?




Besides this:

5 other "less popular" things that you will get living abroad

1) You get to know yourself more than ever (take a trip to yourself). And explore your own thoughts, talk to new people, be out of your comfort zone.







3) You will boost your CV (not just on language skills) but personal growth, problem solving, international perspective...



4) You will become more welcoming to different cultures and ethnicities. Diversity and inclusion will become even more important to you as a Global citizen.



5) Your neuroplasticity grows, you get more creative and a great problem solver! You get for sure more confident!

Traineeships: curricular extracurricular recent graduate **Erasmus+ Program**

Aimed at: Students enrolled in an official UIC degree

How to find internships:

- Contact the companies you are interested in directly
- Internship coordinator (when applicable)

Internships:

- curricular
- extracurricular
- recent graduate

Erasmus+ Program

When?

- Curricular: within the academic year.
- Extracurricular: out of school period (summer).
- Recent graduate: from the closing of acts. The internship must be completed within 12 months of obtaining the degree

Funding application: The student will apply for an Erasmus+ grant through RRII, filling in the documentation before & after the mobility stay.

Duration: minimum of 2 months and maximum of 3.



Erasmus+ grant



Grupo 1	Denmark, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden	460€/month
Región 14	United Kingdom* *until the 30th of April 2023	400€/month
Grupo 2	Germany, Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, The Netherlands, Portugal	410€/month
Grupo 3	North Macedonia, Bulgaria, Croacia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Czech Republic, Romania, Serbia, Turkey	360€/month

- Amount to be decided depending on the country, by the National Erasmus Agency (SEPIE).
- Awarded automatically to whoever is selected by the Faculties and submits all required documents - Valid NIE
- > Funding for a maximum of 3 months
- Processed by UIC Barcelona.

+ 250€/month:

- students with a scholarship from the Ministry / the Basque Country
- refugee status
- disability of 33% or more


