English C1.2

Presentation

A 40-hour face-to-face course focused on improving the English level of teachers and researchers up to a C1.2 level.

Course Overview

This is a mid C1 level course. Its objectives are to improve the English level of teachers and researchers in order to reach the level of English necessary to go towards a C1 level exam, such as an official advanced certificate exam (for example, CAE) or the Certificat de Capacitació per a la Docència en Anglès (CLUC-EMI). This 40-hour course will be a step towards obtaining the level necessary to eventually earn a C1 certificate, which is required by UIC Barcelona for those wishing to teach in English.

Please note: a 40-hour course is not enough to go from a B2 to a C1 level. According to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), this requires around 150 hours of study.

Prerequisites

Students should have participated in the C1.1 course, or have an equivalent level. A level test may need to be taken before admission to the course. This is to confirm that everyone has the appropriate level and will be able to follow the course content.

Objectives

To improve the English level of PDI with the aim of certifying a C1 level in the future.

Syllabus for English C1.2

Based on Units 6 to 10 of **English File Advanced, 3rd edition**, the material will include: Grammar – use infinitive or gerund, conditionals, modal verbs, verbs of senses, future tenses, ellipsis, compound and possessive noun forms, cleft sentences and relative clauses. Language and topics are focused on talking about lifestyles, stress and technology, intelligence, art, health, travel, pets, eating out, where you live and sports.
